Course: Latin 1 372-373

Essential learning outcomes: After successfully completing this course, students will be able to:

1. read words, phrases, and simple sentences and associate them with pictures, and/or other words, phrases and simple sentences.
2. demonstrate a knowledge of vocabulary, basic inflectional systems, and syntax appropriate to their Latin reading level.
3. demonstrate reading comprehension by answering simple questions in English about short passages of Latin.
4. acquire information about the Greco-Roman world by reading passages of Latin with a culturally authentic setting.
5. demonstrate a basic knowledge of the daily life of the ancient Romans and are able to compare and contrast aspects of their own daily life with them.
6. demonstrate knowledge of some famous Romans and principal Roman deities and heroes.
7. show evidence of becoming lifelong learners by understanding a specialized vocabulary in professional fields and such fields as government and politics, and its use in the media.
8. demonstrate a basic knowledge of the Latin roots, prefixes and suffixes by recognizing them in English words of Latin origin.
9. demonstrate an understanding of basic language patterns of English as they relate to the structure of Latin.
