Catholic Memorial Varsity Girls' Soccer Team Earns 12th Consecutive NSCAA/adidas Academic All-American Team Award

Waukesha, Wis. – For the 12th consecutive year, the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) has selected the Catholic Memorial High School (CMH) varsity girls soccer team as recipients of the NSCAA/adidas Academic All-American Team Award, recognizing the team's achievement of academic excellence. The CMH varsity girls' soccer team earned the highest G.P.A. of all schools in Wisconsin with a 3.71 average G.P.A. during the 2010-2011 school year. The team will be recognized at the NSCAA national convention in Kansas City, Mo. this month.

The Catholic Memorial girls' soccer team is one of only nine teams in the country to have earned NSCAA Academic All-American Team honors for every year that the award has existed.

In addition, the CMH girls' soccer team has also excelled on the field over the course of eight years, winning twelve Classic 8 conference titles, seven WISAA and WIAA state titles, and a NSCAA national championship.

In addition to their academic and sports-related achievements, the girls soccer team continues their service to the handicapped children of Waukesha County through the TOPSoccer program.
