




TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

CONVENIENT, LOW-COST BUS SERVICE TO AND FROM CATHOLIC MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL

Safe and reliable school bus transportation is provided by First Student, a highly recognized and respected school bus transportation company. Bus service is available to and from CMH via three routes servicing 10 convenient drop-off/pick-up locations. These locations were chosen based on the priority rankings of the survey participants.

NEW BERLIN AND WAUKESHA BUS INFORMATION

New Berlin and Waukesha School District Residents - Currently students
living within these school districts are transported free of charge. We
anticipate this will continue for the 2022-2023 school year. However, bussing
decisions are made within the respective school districts and changes may
occur.



Waukesha School District Residents – Students must live two miles or more
from CMH to receive free transportation. However, bussing can be provided for a fee if students live less than two
miles from CMH. See FIRST STUDENT PAY TO RIDE PROGRAM.

FIRST STUDENT PAY TO RIDE PROGRAM

The Pay to Ride program is available for those students who live outside of their school attendance boundary or for students
who live within the two-mile radius of their neighborhood school. The student must be picked up and dropped off at an existing
stop location and must have seating room available on the bus. Please keep in mind this is on a first come, first serve basis.
Application are available on the Waukesha School District and New Berlin School website under Transportation.
 Please note the application deadline.

GENERAL TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

- A bus registration form will be included in enrollment agreements mailed in March. This must be filled out and returned to school by March 31, 2022 in order for bus companies to confirm eligibility and to allow time to schedule pick-up times and locations.
- Information on bus routes and the place and approximate time of student's pick-up will be provided by the bus company just prior to the beginning of school.
- Elmbrook and Pewaukee District Residents Transportation reimbursement may be available through the school district. Please contact the public school district to see if you qualify.
- Other School District Residents Students in areas where busing is not available but may be within close proximity of the Waukesha or New Berlin School Districts might be able to ride the bus for a fee. Arrangements must be made on an individual basis with the school district bus company.

CAR POOLS

• Car pools are not facilitated through the school but can be set up on an individual basis between families. A family directory is available for purchase at Back-To-School Day (just prior to school starting) which is an excellent resource for finding families in your area.
